## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1
- Consolidated Statutes, in assault, providing for first 2
- responder intimidation.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7
- 8 § 2710.1. First responder intimidation.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits the offense of
- 10 identity intimidation if, with malicious intention, the person
- commits an offense under any other provision of this chapter or 11
- under Chapter 33 (relating to arson, criminal mischief and other 12
- property destruction) exclusive of section 3307 (relating to 13
- 14 institutional vandalism) or under section 3503 (relating to
- 15 criminal trespass) with respect to the individual or the
- 16 individual's property or with respect to one or more members of
- the group or to the member's property. 17

- 1 <u>(b) Grading.--</u>
- 2 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), an offense
- 3 under this section shall be classified as a misdemeanor of
- 4 <u>the third degree if the other offense is classified as a</u>
- 5 <u>summary offense.</u>
- 6 (2) An offense under this section shall be classified
- 7 <u>one degree higher in the classification specified in section</u>
- 8 <u>106 (relating to classes of offenses) than the classification</u>
- 9 <u>of the other offense.</u>
- 10 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 11 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 12 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 <u>"Emergency medical services provider." The term shall have</u>
- 14 the same meaning as provided under 35 Pa.C.S. § 8103 (relating
- 15 <u>to definitions</u>).
- 16 <u>"Firefighter." A professional or volunteer firefighter.</u>
- "Law enforcement officer." The term shall have the same
- 18 meaning as the term "peace officer" under section 501 (relating
- 19 to definitions).
- 20 "Malicious intention." The intention to commit an act, the
- 21 commission of which is a necessary element of an offense
- 22 referred to under subsection (a) motivated by hatred toward the
- 23 employment as a law enforcement officer, firefighter or
- 24 emergency medical service provider of another individual or
- 25 group of individuals.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
