AN ACT

1 2	"An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3	special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4	primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5	and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6	imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7	courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8	imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9	revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10	repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11	elections," providing for conduct of early voting in
12	primaries and elections.

- 1 The county board of each county shall provide for early
- 2 voting to begin 30 days prior to the dates of elections and
- 3 primaries established in accordance with Article VI and to end
- 4 the Friday before the starting date.
- 5 <u>Section 1202-A. Early voting sites.</u>
- 6 Early voting shall be conducted at the main office of the
- 7 county board or any alternative sites designated by the county
- 8 board during the early voting period established in accordance
- 9 with section 1201-A. The county board shall make available at
- 10 these sites the same equipment used on election day as provided
- 11 for in Article XI.
- 12 Section 1203-A. Days and times for opening and closing polls at
- 13 <u>early voting sites.</u>
- 14 The county board of each county shall designate the days and
- 15 hours that early voting sites will be open, provided that all
- 16 sites throughout the county shall have uniform days and hours,
- 17 shall be open eight hours each weekday, shall be open a minimum
- 18 of an aggregate eight hours each weekend and shall not open
- 19 prior to 7 a.m. Eastern Standard Time or close before 7 p.m.
- 20 <u>Eastern Standard Time</u>.
- 21 Section 1204-A. Voter's certificates and elector
- 22 <u>identification</u>.
- 23 At each early voting site, the county board shall prepare a
- 24 suitable number of voter's certificates as provided by section
- 25 1203. Each elector who appears to vote at an early voting site
- 26 shall complete a voter certificate and shall present to an
- 27 <u>election officer one of the forms of photo identification as</u>
- 28 established in section 1210.
- 29 <u>Section 1205-A. Voting check list.</u>
- 30 The county board shall maintain a voting check list as

- 1 provided for in section 1212 in such a way to ensure that
- 2 <u>electors are prohibited from casting additional ballots at</u>
- 3 either an early voting site or on election day in their
- 4 precinct.
- 5 <u>Section 1206-A.</u> <u>Disposition of returns.</u>
- 6 The county board shall track votes by precinct but shall not
- 7 tabulate votes prior to the close of the polls on election day.
- 8 <u>Section 1207-A. Applicability of Article XII.</u>
- 9 Except as provided in this article, the provisions of Article
- 10 XII shall apply to early voting in primaries and elections.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
