## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing November 19, 2014, as "American Made Matters Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, November 19, 2014, has been declared as the first
- 4 annual "American Made Matters Day"; and
- 5 WHEREAS, On November 19, 2014, consumers are encouraged to
- 6 buy at least one American-made product to show their support for
- 7 American manufacturing. The day will also kick off a movement
- 8 encouraging Americans to buy products made in America throughout
- 9 the upcoming holiday shopping season; and
- 10 WHEREAS, American Made Matters Day has been declared because
- 11 of the positive impact that American manufacturing has on jobs
- 12 and its effect on local communities, the United States economy,
- 13 product safety, the environment and the future of America; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The United States Bureau of Economic Analysis
- 2 reports that every \$1 spent on American-made goods invests an
- 3 additional \$1.35 in the United States economy. According to the
- 4 Federal Advanced Manufacturing Portal, one new manufacturing job
- 5 creates 1.6 additional jobs in local service businesses. Jobs in
- 6 high-tech manufacturing industries generate up to five local
- 7 service jobs and demand in other industries, such as technology,
- 8 supply chain management and logistics; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
- 10 November 19, 2014, as "American Made Matters Day" in
- 11 Pennsylvania.
