## AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, providing for veterans registry. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 8 § 712. Veterans registry. <--9 (a) Establishment of veterans registry.
- shall establish a registry of veterans residing in this 10
- 11 Commonwealth in order to provide information on available State
- 12 benefits, programs and services to registered veterans.
- 13 (b) Coordination with State agencies.
- 14 in coordination with other State agencies that have contact with
- 15 veterans, establish a system for State agencies to communicate
- 16 to the department information about veterans who wish to be

- 1 <u>included in the registry. The department shall develop</u>
- 2 procedures and forms as deemed necessary to facilitate the
- 3 implementation of this subsection, including an opt out
- 4 provision for veterans who choose not to be included in the
- 5 <u>registry.</u>
- 6 (c) Duties of State agencies. State agencies under
- 7 subsection (b) shall:
- 8 <u>(1) Develop a mechanism to identify veterans the agency</u>
- 9 <u>serves for the purpose of expanding the registry.</u>
- 10 (2) For each veteran who wishes to be included in the
- 11 registry, provide to the department sufficient information
- for the department to add the veteran to the registry.
- 13 (d) Use of information. Information collected under this
- 14 section for the registry may not be sold or used for commercial
- 15 purposes or otherwise used for purposes not specified under this
- 16 <del>section.</del>
- 17 (e) Report. By July 31, 2018, and each year thereafter, the
- 18 department shall submit to the chairperson and minority
- 19 chairperson of the Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness
- 20 Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority
- 21 chairperson of the Veterans Affairs and Emergency Preparedness
- 22 Committee of the House of Representatives a report on the
- 23 registry to include:
- 24 <u>(1) Active membership.</u>
- 25 (2) Referrals received by other State agencies.
- 26 (3) Number of individuals that opted out of inclusion in
- 27 the registry.
- 28 (4) Outreach expenses incurred by the department.
- 29 (f) Guidelines. The Adjutant General shall adopt and
- 30 promulgate guidelines necessary to carry out the provisions of

- 2 § 712. VETERANS REGISTRY.
- 3 (A) ESTABLISHMENT OF VETERANS REGISTRY.--THE DEPARTMENT

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- 4 SHALL ESTABLISH A REGISTRY OF VETERANS RESIDING IN THIS
- 5 COMMONWEALTH IN ORDER TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON FEDERAL, STATE
- 6 AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT BENEFITS, PROGRAMS AND SERVICES AVAILABLE
- 7 TO VETERANS AND TO LINK VETERANS WITH RESOURCES THAT CAN PROVIDE
- 8 ASSISTANCE. UPON REGISTRATION, IF PERMISSION IS GRANTED BY THE
- 9 REGISTRANT, THE REGISTRANT'S INFORMATION SHALL BE SHARED WITH
- 10 COUNTY DIRECTORS OF VETERANS AFFAIRS AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES.
- 11 (B) COORDINATION WITH STATE AGENCIES.--THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 12 COORDINATE WITH OTHER STATE AGENCIES THAT HAVE CONTACT WITH
- 13 VETERANS TO ESTABLISH A PAPER AND ONLINE REGISTRY FORM TO ENABLE
- 14 STATE AGENCIES TO ASSIST THE DEPARTMENT IN REGISTERING VETERANS
- 15 WHO WISH TO BE INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRY.
- 16 (C) DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT.--THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE
- 17 ACCESS TO A PAPER AND ONLINE FORM WHICH CONTAINS A STATEMENT
- 18 INDICATING THE PURPOSE FOR THE REGISTRY. THE FORM SHALL BE
- 19 DEVELOPED TO OBTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION RELATING TO THE
- 20 VETERAN:
- 21 (1) PERSONAL INFORMATION, INCLUDING TITLE, FIRST, MIDDLE
- 22 AND LAST NAME.
- 23 (2) AGE, GENDER, ADDRESS AND COUNTY OF RESIDENCE.
- 24 (3) TEN-DIGIT PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS.
- 25 (4) DECLARATION OF MILITARY SERVICE.
- 26 (5) BENEFIT AND PROGRAM INFORMATION REQUESTS FOR VARIOUS
- 27 BENEFITS AND PROGRAMS FOR WHICH VETERANS MAY BE ELIGIBLE.
- 28 (6) A SIGNED STATEMENT, OR FOR ONLINE APPLICANTS A BOX
- 29 THAT IS CHECKED, INDICATING THAT THE VETERAN GRANTS
- 30 PERMISSION FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO STORE AND SHARE THE

- 1 VETERAN'S INFORMATION WITH THE COUNTY DIRECTOR OF VETERANS
- 2 AFFAIRS FOR THE COUNTY INDICATED AND WITH OTHER STATE
- 3 AGENCIES TO ENSURE THAT THE COMMONWEALTH PROVIDES THE VETERAN
- 4 ASSISTANCE IN RECEIVING EARNED BENEFITS.
- 5 (7) THE STATE AGENCY WHICH ASSISTED THE VETERAN.
- 6 (D) DUTIES OF STATE AGENCIES. -- STATE AGENCIES UNDER
- 7 SUBSECTION (B) SHALL:
- 8 (1) UTILIZE THE PAPER OR ONLINE REGISTRY FORM TO DEVELOP
- 9 A MECHANISM TO IDENTIFY VETERANS THE AGENCY SERVES FOR THE
- 10 PURPOSE OF EXPANDING THE REGISTRY.
- 11 (2) FOR EACH VETERAN WHO WISHES TO BE INCLUDED IN THE
- 12 REGISTRY, PROVIDE ASSISTANCE IN FILLING OUT THE PAPER OR
- ONLINE REGISTRY FORM FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO ADD THE VETERAN TO
- 14 THE REGISTRY.
- 15 (3) SUBMIT A REGISTRANT'S PAPER REGISTRY FORM TO THE
- 16 <u>DEPARTMENT WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE THE VETERAN OPTS IN</u>
- 17 TO THE REGISTRY.
- 18 (E) USE OF INFORMATION.--INFORMATION COLLECTED UNDER THIS
- 19 SECTION MAY NOT BE SOLD OR USED FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES OR USED
- 20 FOR PURPOSES NOT SPECIFIED UNDER THIS SECTION. INFORMATION
- 21 COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION FOR THE REGISTRY SHALL BE EXEMPT
- 22 FROM BEING DISCLOSED UNDER THE ACT OF FEBRUARY 14, 2008 (P.L.6,
- 23 NO.3), KNOWN AS THE RIGHT-TO-KNOW LAW.
- 24 (F) REPORT. -- BY JANUARY 1, 2018, AND EACH JANUARY 1
- 25 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE CHAIRPERSON AND
- 26 MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS AND EMERGENCY
- 27 PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE CHAIRPERSON AND
- 28 MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS AND EMERGENCY
- 29 PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES A REPORT
- 30 ON THE REGISTRY WHICH SHALL INCLUDE:

- 1 (1) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VETERANS REGISTERED WITH THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT ANNUALLY.
- 3 (2) THE NUMBER OF REGISTRANTS RECEIVED BY EACH STATE
- 4 <u>AGENCY</u>.
- 5 (3) THE NUMBER OF VETERANS WHO CHOOSE NOT TO BE INCLUDED
- 6 <u>IN THE REGISTRY ANNUALLY FROM EACH STATE AGENCY.</u>
- 7 (4) OUTREACH EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 8 (G) GUIDELINES. -- THE ADJUTANT GENERAL MAY ADOPT AND
- 9 PROMULGATE GUIDELINES NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF
- 10 THIS SECTION.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
