AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for special speed limitations.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 3365(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 3365. Special speed limitations.
- 8 * * *
- 9 [(d) Penalty.--Any person violating any provision of this
- 10 section is guilty of]
- 11 <u>(d) Penalty.--</u>
- 12 (1) Any person who violates subsection (a), (c) or (c.1)
- 13 <u>commits</u> a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
- sentenced to pay a fine of \$35. Any person exceeding a
- 15 maximum speed limit established under [this section]
- 16 <u>subsection (a), (c) or (c.1)</u> by more than five miles per hour

1 shall pay an additional fine of \$2 per mile for each mile in 2 excess of five miles per hour in excess of the maximum speed 3 limit.

(2) Any person who violates subsection (b) commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced as follows:

(i) For a first conviction, pay a fine of \$50. Any person exceeding a maximum speed limit established under subsection (b) by more than five miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2 per mile for each mile in excess of five miles per hour in excess of the maximum speed limit.

(ii) For a second conviction, pay a fine of \$100. Any person exceeding a maximum speed limit established under subsection (b) by more than five miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2 per mile for each mile in excess of five miles per hour in excess of the maximum speed limit. In addition, the court, including a court not of record if it is exercising jurisdiction pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 1515(a) (relating to jurisdiction and venue), shall order the operating privilege of the person suspended for a period of 60 days. A copy of the order shall be transmitted to the department.

(iii) For a third and subsequent conviction, pay a fine of \$250. Any person exceeding a maximum speed limit established under subsection (b) by more than five miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2 per mile for each mile in excess of five miles per hour in excess of the maximum speed limit. In addition, the court,

including a court not of record if it is exercising
