## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in particular rights and
- immunities, providing for civil immunity for volunteer
- 4 practitioners.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 8337.2. Civil immunity for volunteer practitioners.
- 10 (a) General rule.--A volunteer practitioner shall be immune
- 11 from civil liability for any act or omission during the course
- 12 of rendering care, within the scope of practice of the volunteer
- 13 practitioner which results in death, damage or injury to a
- 14 patient, if, before services are rendered, the volunteer
- 15 practitioner provides oral and written notice to the patient or
- 16 the patient's quardian, if applicable, that:
- 17 (1) The service is being provided on a volunteer basis

- 1 and is not being rendered in expectation of compensation.
- 2 (2) In exchange for such services, the patient
- 3 relinguishes any and all civil claims for damages against the
- 4 <u>volunteer practitioner.</u>
- 5 (b) Vicarious liability. -- No vicarious liability shall
- 6 attach to the employer of a volunteer practitioner.
- 7 (c) Nonapplicability. -- This section shall not apply to an
- 8 intentional tort.
- 9 (d) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 10 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 11 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Approved clinic." An organized community-based clinic
- 13 <u>offering health care services to individuals and families who</u>
- 14 cannot pay for their care, to medical assistance clients or to
- 15 <u>residents of medically underserved areas or health professionals</u>
- 16 shortage areas. The term includes, but shall not be limited to,
- 17 a State health center, nonprofit community-based clinic and
- 18 federally qualified health center as designated by Federal
- 19 rulemaking or as approved by the Department of Health or the
- 20 Department of Human Services.
- 21 <u>"Health care practitioner." A person licensed or approved by</u>
- 22 the Commonwealth to provide health care or professional medical
- 23 services as a physician, certified registered nurse
- 24 practitioner, registered nurse, physician assistant, certified
- 25 nurse midwife or podiatrist.
- 26 "Volunteer practitioner." A health care practitioner who
- 27 provides health care services at an approved clinic without
- 28 remuneration from the approved clinic.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
