- 7 CONSOLIDATED STATUTES IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 8 § 3733. FLEEING OR ATTEMPTING TO ELUDE POLICE OFFICER.
- 9 (A) OFFENSE DEFINED[.--] AND PENALTIES.--
- 10 (1) ANY DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WHO WILLFULLY FAILS OR
- 11 REFUSES TO BRING HIS VEHICLE TO A STOP, OR WHO OTHERWISE
- 12 FLEES OR ATTEMPTS TO ELUDE A PURSUING POLICE OFFICER, WHEN
- 13 GIVEN A VISUAL AND AUDIBLE SIGNAL TO BRING THE VEHICLE TO A
- 14 STOP, COMMITS A MISDEMEANOR OF THE SECOND DEGREE. ANY DRIVER
- 15 UPON CONVICTION SHALL PAY AN ADDITIONAL FINE OF \$500. THIS
- 16 FINE SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO AND NOT IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER
- 17 FINES, COURT EXPENSES, JAIL SENTENCES OR PENALTIES.
- 18 (2) ANY DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WHO WILLFULLY FAILS OR
- 19 REFUSES TO BRING HIS VEHICLE TO A STOP, OR WHO OTHERWISE
- 20 FLEES OR ATTEMPTS TO ELUDE A PURSUING POLICE OFFICER, WHILE
- 21 ENGAGED IN A VIOLATION OF SECTION 3802 (RELATING TO DRIVING
- 22 UNDER INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE), WHEN
- 23 GIVEN A VISUAL AND AUDIBLE SIGNAL TO BRING THE VEHICLE TO A
- 24 STOP, COMMITS A MISDEMEANOR OF THE FIRST DEGREE. ANY DRIVER
- 25 UPON CONVICTION SHALL BE SENTENCED TO PAY AN ADDITIONAL FINE
- 26 OF NOT LESS THAN \$1,000 AND TO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT LESS THAN
- 27 72 CONSECUTIVE HOURS. THIS FINE SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO AND
- 28 NOT IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER FINES, COURT EXPENSES, JAIL
- 29 SENTENCES OR PENALTIES.
