## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 27, 1937 (P.L.917), entitled "An act for the protection of the health and welfare of women and minors by regulating under the police power the minimum fair wages which shall be paid by employers; providing for wage boards, and defining the powers and duties of such boards, and of the Department of Labor and Industry; imposing duties on employers; providing for directory and mandatory orders on employers, and the publication of the names of employers who do not comply with such orders; exempting certain persons from the provisions of this act; and providing penalties," reducing certain age requirements.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:
