## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, further defining the offense of 2
- 3 retaliation against witness or victim.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4953 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7
- 8 § 4953. Retaliation against witness or victim.
- 9 Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense if he (a)
- 10 harms, attempts to harm or threatens to harm another by any
- 11 unlawful act in retaliation for anything lawfully done in the
- 12 capacity of witness or victim.
- 13 Grading. -- The offense is a felony of the third degree if
- 14 the retaliation is accomplished by any of the means specified in
- 15 section 4952(b)(1) through (5) (relating to intimidation of
- witnesses or victims). Otherwise the offense is a misdemeanor of 16
- the second degree. 17
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 18
