9	(a) PowersAny officer whose duty it is to enforce this
10	title or any officer investigating any alleged violation of this
11	title shall have the power and duty to:

13	(17) When [acting within the scope of the officer's
14	employment] <u>in the performance of duty</u> , pursue, apprehend or
15	arrest any individual suspected of violating any provision of
16	Title 18 (relating to crimes and offenses) <u>or 75 (relating to</u>
17	vehicles) or any other offense classified as a misdemeanor or
18	felony. The officer shall also have the power to serve and

execute warrants issued by the proper authorities for offenses referred to in this paragraph and to serve subpoenas issued for examination. All powers as provided for in this paragraph will be limited by such administrative procedure as the director, with the approval of the commission, shall prescribe. The regulations shall be promulgated within 90 days of the effective date of this paragraph.
