## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, repealing provisions related to nonemergency medical 4 transportation services. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 8 Section 1. Section 443.12 of the act of June 13, 1967 9 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is repealed: 10 [Section 443.12. Nonemergency Medical Transportation 11 Services .-- (a) The department shall amend the Commonwealth's 12 State Plan under Title XIX of the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 13 620, 42 U.S.C. § 1396 et seq.) to provide nonemergency medical
- transportation services to eligible and enrolled medical
- 15 assistance recipients utilizing a Statewide or regional full-
- 16 risk brokerage model.
- 17 (b) Subject to Federal approval of the amendments to the

- 1 Commonwealth's approved Title XIX State Plan, the department
- 2 shall develop a proposal and solicit a broker to administer the
- 3 program. A broker determined eligible by the department may
- 4 submit a proposal. The department shall enter into a contract
- 5 with each broker whose proposal has been selected to administer
- 6 the program.
- 7 (c) The department shall issue the solicitation for a
- 8 Statewide or regional full-risk brokerage model within one
- 9 hundred eighty days after the effective date of this subsection.
- (d) The department may not enter into a contract with a
- 11 broker under subsection (b) prior to the completion of the
- 12 analysis required under subsection (e). ((d) added June 28,
- 13 2019, P.L.168, No.19)
- (e) Prior to the implementation of the full-risk brokerage
- 15 model, the department, in coordination with the Department of
- 16 Transportation and the Department of Aging, shall commission an
- 17 analysis that provides at a minimum the following:
- 18 (1) An analysis of current Federal and State law,
- 19 regulations and policies controlling the nonemergency medical
- 20 transportation and other human services transportation programs
- 21 administered in the Commonwealth, including the authorized
- 22 methods of delivery and limitations or restrictions imposed on
- 23 the methods of delivery.
- 24 (2) An analysis of the effectiveness and efficiency of the
- 25 current nonemergency transportation service delivery as it
- 26 relates to all human service programs in this Commonwealth.
- 27 (3) A review of other states' models of delivering
- 28 nonemergency medical and other human services transportation,
- 29 including the number of other states that utilize a full-risk
- 30 brokerage model and the effect a brokerage model has had on

- 1 public transit in those states.
- 2 (4) An analysis of the positive and negative impact of
- 3 maintaining the current transportation delivery model versus
- 4 implementing a full-risk brokerage model as it relates to the
- 5 State and local government entities, including financial impact.
- 6 (5) An analysis of the impact on consumers, including an
- 7 increase or decrease in quality and service availability.
- 8 ((e) added June 28, 2019, P.L.168, No.19)
- 9 (f) The analysis under subsection (e) shall be completed no
- 10 later than one hundred eighty days from the effective date of
- 11 this subsection. A preliminary report of the analysis under
- 12 subsection (e) shall be completed no later than ninety days from
- 13 the effective date of this subsection. The analysis under
- 14 subsection (e) and the preliminary report under this subsection
- 15 shall be delivered to the following:
- 16 (1) The Secretary of Human Services.
- 17 (2) The Secretary of Aging.
- 18 (3) The Secretary of Transportation.
- (4) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 20 Appropriations Committee of the Senate.
- 21 (5) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 22 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 23 (6) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Health
- 24 and Human Services Committee of the Senate.
- (7) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the Health
- 26 Committee of the House of Representatives.]
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
