AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the number of occupants of vehicles in high occupancy lanes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 3313 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 3313. Restrictions on use of limited access highways.
(a) General rule.--[The] Subject to the limitations of subsection (c), the department may regulate or prohibit the use of any limited access highway by any class or kind of traffic which is found to be incompatible with the normal and safe movement of traffic.
(b) Traffic-control devices at entrances.--The department, when adopting any prohibition under this section, shall erect and maintain official traffic-control devices at the entrances to the limited access highway on which the prohibitions are applicable and when in place no person shall disobey the
restrictions stated on the devices.
(c) High occupancy vehicle lane restrictions.--Any high
occupancy vehicle lane restrictions prescribed for Interstate
279 in counties of the second class shall provide that vehicles
with a driver and one other occupant may use the restricted lane
for travel.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
