## A SUPPLEMENT

- 1 To the act of July 3, 1984 (P.L.583, No.117), entitled "An act
- 2 providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1984-
- 3 1985, " itemizing a beach erosion control project for Presque
- 4 Isle State Park.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Total authorization.
- 8 The total authorization for the additional capital projects
- 9 in the category of public improvement projects itemized in
- 10 section 2 and to be acquired or constructed by the Department of
- 11 General Services, its successors or assigns, and to be financed
- 12 by the incurring of debt, shall be \$1,600,000.
- 13 Section 2. Itemization of public improvement projects.
- 14 Additional capital projects in the category of public
- 15 improvement projects to be acquired or constructed by the
- 16 Department of General Services, its successors or assigns, and
- 17 to be financed by the incurring of debt, are hereby itemized,
- 18 together with their respective estimated financial costs, as

- 1 follows:
- 2 Total
- 3 Project
- 4 Project Allocation
- 5 (1) Department of Environmental Resources \$1,600,000
- 6 (i) Presque Isle State Park
- 7 (A) Beach erosion control 1,600,000
- 8 (Base Project Allocation \$1,455,000)
- 9 (Design and Contingencies \$145,000)
- 10 Section 3. Debt authorization.
- 11 The Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby
- 12 authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, in
- 13 addition to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted,
- 14 on the credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations
- 15 provided in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in
- 16 the aggregate the sum of \$1,600,000 as may be found necessary to
- 17 carry out the acquisition and construction of the public
- 18 improvement projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.
- 19 Section 4. Issue of bonds.
- The indebtedness authorized in this act shall be incurred,
- 21 from time to time, and shall be evidenced by one or more series
- 22 of general obligation bonds of the Commonwealth in such
- 23 aggregate principal amount for each series as the Governor,
- 24 Auditor General and State Treasurer shall determine, but the
- 25 latest stated maturity date shall not exceed the estimated
- 26 useful life of the projects being financed as stated in section
- 27 5.
- 28 Section 5. Estimated useful life and term of debt.
- 29 (a) Estimated useful life. -- The General Assembly states that
- 30 the estimated useful life of the public improvement projects

- 1 itemized in this act is 30 years.
- 2 (b) Term of debt.--The maximum term of the debt authorized
- 3 to be incurred under this act is 30 years.
- 4 Section 6. Appropriation.
- 5 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations authorized in
- 6 this act are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
- 7 Fund to the Department of General Services in the maximum amount
- 8 of \$1,600,000 to be used by it exclusively to defray the
- 9 financial cost of the public improvement projects specifically
- 10 itemized in a capital budget. After reserving or paying the
- 11 expenses of the sale of the obligation, the State Treasurer
- 12 shall pay to the Department of General Services the moneys as
- 13 required and certified by it to be legally due and payable.
- 14 Section 7. Federal funds.
- In addition to those funds appropriated in section 6, all
- 16 moneys received from the Federal Government for the projects
- 17 specifically itemized in this act are also hereby appropriated
- 18 for those projects.
- 19 Section 8. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
