## HOUSE BILL No. 2101 Session of 1979

INTRODUCED BY MR. McCLATCHY, DECEMBER 11, 1979

AS REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, FEBRUARY 4, 1980

## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 4, 1979 (No.9A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and 3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1980, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending 7 June 30, 1979, "changing certain appropriations and language. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 2, act of July 4, 1979 (No.9A), known as the "General Appropriation Act of 1979," is amended by changing 11 12 certain appropriations in the Governor's Office, Treasury 13 Department, the Departments of Agriculture and Environmental Resources, General Services, Health, Justice, Public Welfare and 14 15 the Judiciary, and changing certain language in the Department of the Auditor General, the Departments of Commerce and Labor 16 17 and Industry, the Legislative Department and the Local 18 Government Commission to read:

Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be

necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General 1 2 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, 3 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the 4 payment of salaries, wages or other compensation and travel 5 expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services 6 rendered, for the purchase or rental of goods, services, 7 printing, equipment, land and buildings and for payment of any other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities and 10 11 for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 1979 and for the payment of bills incurred and 12 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 13 30, 1979. 14 15 I.
