AN ACT

1 Designating a certain bridge crossing the Ohio River as the
2 Glenfield Bridge.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The bridge carrying Interstate Highway 79 over
6 the Ohio River between the Borough of Glenfield and Robinson
7 Township in Allegheny County is hereby officially designated and
8 shall be known as the "Glenfield Bridge."

9 Section 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall erect
10 suitable markers in order to carry out the provisions of this
11 act.

12 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
