Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for 2 purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of liquor 3 or malt or brewed beverages. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 6308 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read: § 6308. Purchase, consumption, possession or transportation of 9 10 liquor or malt or brewed beverages. 11 12 (q) Exception for person receiving medical attention. -- A person shall be immune from prosecution for consumption or 13 possession under subsection (a) and for a violation of probation 14 15 or parole if the person can establish all of the following: 16 (1) The person came to the attention of law enforcement 17 as a result of a request for immediate medical attention to 18 prevent death or serious injury.

(2) The person agrees to undergo a drug and alcohol

- 5 (h) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "drug and
- 6 <u>alcohol assessment" means an assessment performed by an</u>
- 7 <u>accredited addiction services provider or professional to</u>
- 8 evaluate an individual's need for any of the following:
- 9 <u>(1) Counseling for drug and alcohol use.</u>
- 10 (2) Treatment for drug and alcohol addiction.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
