AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing
- 3 for capital grants.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7385.1. Capital grants.
- 9 (a) Source. -- Money transferred under 3 Pa.C.S. § 1113(a)(5)
- 10 and (6) (relating to disposition of certain funds) shall be
- 11 utilized by the commissioner to administer capital grants.
- 12 (b) Recipients. -- Emergency services training centers
- 13 recognized by the commissioner under standards developed through
- 14 rules and guidelines in consultation with the State Fire
- 15 Advisory Board may be recipients of grants under subsection (a)
- 16 upon application.
- 17 (c) Purposes. -- Capital grants administered to recipients

- 1 under this section shall be used to:
- 2 (1) Establish or modernize facilities that house
- 3 firefighting equipment, ambulances or rescue vehicles.
- 4 <u>(2) Acquire or renovate existing structures to house</u>
- 5 <u>firefighting equipment</u>, <u>ambulances or rescue vehicles or for</u>
- 6 the construction or modernization of facilities.
- 7 (3) Repair or purchase firefighting, ambulance or rescue
- 8 <u>equipment</u>.
- 9 (4) Train and certify members.
- 10 (5) Educate the general public regarding fire prevention
- 11 <u>and community risk reduction.</u>
- 12 (6) Recruit and retain, including providing for
- 13 <u>volunteer firefighter length of service award programs and</u>
- 14 <u>programs for minors.</u>
- 15 (d) Restrictions. -- Capital grants administered under this
- 16 section may not be used for:
- 17 (1) Operating expenses.
- 18 (2) Refinancing of renovated structures.
- 19 (3) Refinancing the construction or modernization of
- 20 facilities.
- 21 (4) Apparatus equipment, communication equipment or
- 22 accessory equipment.
- 23 (5) Reduction of debt or other obligations issued prior
- 24 to the effective date of this section.
- 25 (e) Applications.--The following apply:
- 26 (1) Every application for a capital grant shall be
- 27 <u>accompanied by a notarized financial statement of the entity</u>
- 28 making the application accompanied with evidence sufficient
- 29 to show need for the grant funding.
- 30 (2) Applications shall be reviewed by the Application

- 1 Review Committee utilizing criteria established under
- 2 subsection (b).
- 3 (f) Amounts and criteria. -- The following apply:
- 4 <u>(1) Capital grant amounts and the criteria for</u>
- 5 <u>determining amounts shall be established by the commissioner</u>
- 6 <u>in consultation with the State Fire Advisory Board.</u>
- 7 (2) An entity may be awarded a capital grant, if
- 8 <u>available</u>, for an approved project in lieu of approved
- 9 reimbursement payments or, if not available, shall receive
- 10 payments in the form of reimbursements.
- 11 (g) Use. -- Capital grants may be used in combination with the
- 12 <u>funding authorized under section 7813(e)</u> (relating to award of
- 13 grants) if an applicant is officially proceeding with an
- 14 approved project evidenced by required documentation as
- 15 determined by the commissioner.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
