A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for action on concurrent
- orders and resolutions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 9 of Article III be amended to read:
- 9 § 9. Action on concurrent orders and resolutions.
- 10 Every order, resolution or vote, to which the concurrence of
- 11 both Houses may be necessary, except on the questions of
- 12 adjournment, disapproval of a regulation or termination or
- 13 extension of a disaster emergency declaration as declared by an
- 14 executive order or proclamation, or portion of a disaster
- 15 emergency declaration as declared by an executive order or
- 16 proclamation, shall be presented to the Governor and before it
- 17 shall take effect be approved by him, or being disapproved,

- 1 shall be repassed by two-thirds of both Houses according to the
- 2 rules and limitations prescribed in case of a bill.
- 3 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 4 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 5 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
- 6 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 7 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- 8 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- 9 of Pennsylvania.
- 10 (2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of
- 11 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this
- 16 Commonwealth at the first primary, general or municipal
- 17 election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article
- 18 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
