AN ACT

1 Providing for the designation by taxpayers on State income tax  
2 forms for the use of certain sums for cancer research and  
3 providing for the appropriation of the sums; and making a  
4 repeal.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Income tax forms.

8 The Secretary of Revenue shall provide on the Commonwealth of  
9 Pennsylvania Income Tax Return forms a section with various  
10 names or designations of organizations or groups involved in  
11 cancer research, after approval by the Secretary of Health.

12 There shall be a blank block preceding the name of each approved  
13 organization or group.

14 Section 2. Voluntary contribution system.

15 A taxpayer may place a check in the block preceding an  
16 approved organization or group with the intention that \$1 of his  
17 tax refund shall be used for the purpose specified. The  
18 taxpayer's designation shall not constitute a charge against the

1 income tax revenue of the Commonwealth.

2 Section 3. Department of Revenue.

3 The Department of Revenue shall, upon receipt of the income  
4 tax form with refund designation, tabulate and earmark the funds  
5 as specified by the taxpayer under section 2.

6 Section 4. Appropriation.

7 The sum specified under section 3 is hereby appropriated from  
8 the General Fund for the use of the approved cancer research  
9 programs in the proportions designated by the taxpayers.

10 Section 5. Repeals.

11 Section 12 of the act of June 23, 1982 (P.L.597, No.170),  
12 known as the Wild Resource Conservation Act, is repealed insofar  
13 as it is inconsistent with this act.

14 Section 6. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect immediately.
