## AN ACT

- Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8654, carrying State Route 3035 over the Little Conemaugh River in East 2 Taylor Township, Cambria County, as the East Taylor Township 3 Veterans Memorial Bridge; designating a bridge, identified as 4 Bridge Key 43558, carrying U.S. Route 22 over a tributary of 5 Hinckston Run in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the 6 Officer Matthew Krupa Memorial Bridge; and designating a 7 bridge, identified as Bridge Key 55994, carrying State Route 8 4002 over California Run in Cambria Township, Cambria County, 9 as the Senior Chief Stanley "Stush" Kubat, Jr., Memorial 10 11 Bridge.
- 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 13 hereby enacts as follows:
- 14 Section 1. East Taylor Township Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- 15 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares that
- 16 this Commonwealth and the nation are indebted to the veterans of
- 17 East Taylor Township, Cambria County, for their bravery, heroism
- 18 and sacrifice in protecting freedom and liberty both at home and
- 19 abroad.
- 20 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8654,
- 21 carrying State Route 3035 over the Little Conemaugh River in
- 22 East Taylor Township, Cambria County, is designated the East
- 23 Taylor Township Veterans Memorial Bridge.

- 1 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 2 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 3 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 4 Section 2. Officer Matthew Krupa Memorial Bridge.
- 5 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (1) Officer Matthew Krupa was born July 25, 1993, in
- 8 Johnstown.
- 9 (2) Officer Krupa was raised in Nanty Glo.
- 10 (3) Officer Krupa graduated from Central Cambria High
- 11 School.
- 12 (4) Officer Krupa sought out to live his childhood dream
- 13 by becoming a police officer.
- 14 (5) Officer Krupa graduated from the police academy and
- started to serve the area as a police officer.
- 16 (6) Officer Krupa served as a police officer for Portage
- Borough, Ferndale Borough, Saint Francis University, Indiana
- 18 University of Pennsylvania and Conemaugh Hospital.
- 19 (7) In 2018, Officer Krupa moved to San Antonio, Texas,
- where he was employed with the Gonzales County Sheriff's
- 21 Office and with the San Antonio Independent School District
- 22 Police Department.
- 23 (8) On February 4, 2021, Officer Krupa was dressed in
- full uniform and on his way to work when he was involved in a
- line of duty car crash that took his life.
- 26 (9) Officer Krupa's lifelong dream was to become a K-9
- officer, and he was in training when he was killed.
- 28 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 29 43558, carrying U.S. Route 22 over a tributary of Hinckston Run
- 30 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, is designated the Officer

- 1 Matthew Krupa Memorial Bridge.
- 2 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 3 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 4 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 5 Section 3. Senior Chief Stanley "Stush" Kubat, Jr., Memorial
- 6 Bridge.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Stanley Kubat, Jr., was born June 29, 1973, in
- Johnstown.
- 11 (2) Senior Chief Kubat served our country for 23 years
- in the United States Navy.
- 13 (3) Senior Chief Kubat was awarded a Bronze Star for his
- 14 service to our nation.
- 15 (4) Senior Chief Kubat enjoyed golfing, hunting and
- 16 fishing.
- 17 (5) Senior Chief Kubat passed away on November 9, 2022.
- 18 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 19 55994, carrying State Route 4002 over California Run in Cambria
- 20 Township, Cambria County, is designated the Senior Chief Stanley
- 21 "Stush" Kubat, Jr., Memorial Bridge.
- 22 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 23 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 24 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 25 Section 4. Effective date.
- 26 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
