11	(a) General ruleAn individual may not smoke in a vehicle
12	that is transporting a child under 12 years of age.
13	(b) Penalty
14	<u>(1) An individual who violates subsection (a) commits a</u>
15	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
16	<u>pay a fine of \$100.</u>
17	(2) An individual who commits a second or subsequent
18	offense after being convicted under paragraph (1) commits a
19	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to

1 <u>pay a fine of \$250.</u>

2	(c) RequirementAn individual may not be convicted of an
3	offense under subsection (a) unless the individual is also
4	convicted of another offense under this title that occurred at
5	the same time.
6	(d) DefinitionAs used in this section, the term "smoke"
7	means to carry a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking
8	device.
9	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
