AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation APPROPRIATIONS to the Trustees of the <--
2 University of Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 ~~Section 1. The sum of \$281,000, or as much thereof as may be <--
6 necessary, is appropriated to the Trustees of the University of
7 Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 2017, to June 30, 2018,
8 for the Division of Infectious Diseases.~~

9 ~~Section 2. (a) The University of Pennsylvania shall provide
10 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by
11 the Department of Agriculture or the chairperson or the minority
12 chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the
13 chairperson or the minority chairperson of the Appropriations
14 Committee of the House of Representatives.~~

15 ~~(b) The University of Pennsylvania shall report its revenues
16 and expenditures and present its financial statements in
17 accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
18 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the~~

1 ~~"Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth~~
2 ~~of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of~~
3 ~~Higher Education, State Related Universities and Non State~~
4 ~~Related Colleges and Universities."~~

5 SECTION 1. (A) THE SUM OF \$30,135,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF <--
6 AS MAY BE NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE TRUSTEES OF
7 THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2017,
8 TO JUNE 30, 2018, FOR VETERINARY ACTIVITIES.

9 (B) THE SUM OF \$281,000, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE
10 NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE TRUSTEES OF THE
11 UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2017, TO
12 JUNE 30, 2018, FOR THE CENTER FOR INFECTIOUS DISEASES.

13 SECTION 2. (A) PAYMENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA
14 ON ACCOUNT OF THE APPROPRIATIONS PROVIDED IN SECTION 1 SHALL BE
15 MADE QUARTERLY BY THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE ON THE BASIS OF
16 COSTS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR AND SHALL BE CONDITIONED ON
17 CONTINUING AUTHORITY FOR INCLUSION ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
18 THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA OF A MINIMUM OF FOUR PERSONS WHO
19 ARE NOT ELECTED OFFICIALS AND WHO ARE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT
20 PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE, THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE,
21 THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE MINORITY
22 LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR TERMS OF OFFICE
23 COTERMINOUS WITH THAT OF THE RESPECTIVE APPOINTING AUTHORITY;
24 AND SHALL BE FURTHER CONDITIONED ON THESE APPOINTEES RECEIVING
25 FULL VOTING RIGHTS AS MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

26 (B) THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA SHALL PROVIDE FULL,
27 COMPLETE AND ACCURATE INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE
28 DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE OR THE CHAIRMAN OR THE MINORITY
29 CHAIRMAN OF THE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE OR THE
30 CHAIRMAN OR THE MINORITY CHAIRMAN OF THE APPROPRIATIONS

1 COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

2 (C) THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA SHALL REPORT ITS REVENUES
3 AND EXPENDITURES AND PRESENT ITS FINANCIAL STATEMENTS IN
4 ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES AND
5 PROCEDURES FOR EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AS SET FORTH IN THE
6 "HIGHER EDUCATION FINANCE MANUAL (1975)" AND THE "COMMONWEALTH
7 OF PENNSYLVANIA BUDGET INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE STATE SYSTEM OF
8 HIGHER EDUCATION, STATE-RELATED UNIVERSITIES AND NON-STATE-
9 RELATED COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES."

10 (D) THE TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA SHALL
11 REPORT ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO
12 BOTH THE CHAIRMAN AND MINORITY CHAIRMAN OF THE APPROPRIATIONS
13 COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE CHAIRMAN AND MINORITY CHAIRMAN
14 OF THE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
15 BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, ON HOW STATE-APPROPRIATED FUNDS WERE
16 EXPENDED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 TO REDUCE THE COSTS TO
17 PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENT STUDENTS OR TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO
18 PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENTS.

19 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017, or
20 immediately, whichever is later.
