AN ACT

Amending the act of July 7, 1947 (P.L.1368, No.542), entitled, as amended, "An act amending, revising and consolidating the 1 2 laws relating to delinquent county, city, except of the first 3 and second class and second class A, borough, town, township, school district, except of the first class and school districts within cities of the second class A, and institution district taxes, providing when, how and upon what 7 property, and to what extent liens shall be allowed for such 8 taxes, the return and entering of claims therefor; the collection and adjudication of such claims, sales of real 10 property, including seated and unseated lands, subject to the 11 lien of such tax claims; the disposition of the proceeds 12 thereof, including State taxes and municipal claims recovered 13 and the redemption of property; providing for the discharge 14 and divestiture by certain tax sales of all estates in 15 property and of mortgages and liens on such property, and the 16 17 proceedings therefor; creating a Tax Claim Bureau in each county, except counties of the first and second class, to act 18 as agent for taxing districts; defining its powers and 19 duties, including sales of property, the management of property taken in sequestration, and the management, sale and 20 21 22 disposition of property heretofore sold to the county 23 commissioners, taxing districts and trustees at tax sales; providing a method for the service of process and notices; 24 imposing duties on taxing districts and their officers and on 25 tax collectors, and certain expenses on counties and for 26 their reimbursement by taxing districts; and repealing 27 existing laws," in sale of property, providing for Optional 28 29 County Demolition and Rehabilitation Fund.

- 30 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 31 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The act of July 7, 1947 (P.L.1368, No.542), known
- 2 as the Real Estate Tax Sale Law, is amended by adding a section
- 3 to read:
- 4 <u>Section 631. Optional County Demolition and Rehabilitation</u>
- 5 Fund. -- (a) Each county of the first, second, second class A,
- 6 third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class and home
- 7 rule charter county of these classes that imposes the fee
- 8 <u>authorized under subsection (b) shall establish a county</u>
- 9 <u>demolition and rehabilitation fund.</u>
- 10 (b) The governing body of the county may, by resolution or
- 11 ordinance, authorize the tax claim bureau of that county to
- 12 charge and collect a fee not to exceed ten per centum (10%) for
- 13 <u>each property sold at tax sale. The fee raised shall be</u>
- 14 <u>deposited into the Optional County Demolition and Rehabilitation</u>
- 15 Fund to be used exclusively for the demolition or
- 16 rehabilitation, or both, of dilapidated buildings on blighted
- 17 property situate in the county.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
