## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the pointing of laser
- 3 beams at law enforcement officers or firefighters.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2705 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2705. Recklessly endangering another person.
- 9 [A] (a) Misdemeanor of the second degree.--Except as
- 10 provided in subsection (b), a person commits a misdemeanor of
- 11 the second degree if he recklessly engages in conduct which
- 12 places or may place another person in danger of death or serious
- 13 bodily injury.
- (b) Laser beams used against law enforcement officers or
- 15 <u>firefighters.--A person commits a felony of the third degree if</u>
- 16 he, while acting in an unofficial capacity, subjects the eyes of
- 17 a law enforcement officer or a firefighter to a laser beam.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
