- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, further
- 6 providing for Keystone Exams.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 121 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added June 30,
- 11 2012 (P.L.684, No.82), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 121. Keystone Exams. -- (a) Subject to annual
- 13 appropriation, not later than the 2020-2021 school year, the
- 14 Department of Education shall develop and implement Keystone
- 15 Exams in the following subjects: algebra I, literature, biology,
- 16 English composition, algebra II, geometry, United States
- 17 history, chemistry, civics and government and world history. The
- 18 State Board of Education shall promulgate regulations, subject
- 19 to the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the
- 20 "Regulatory Review Act," necessary to implement this section.

- 1 (b) Notwithstanding section 2604-B(b)(2)(v), 22 Pa. Code
- 2 4.24 (relating to high school graduation requirements), 4.51
- 3 <u>(relating to State assessment system) or 4.51c (relating to </u>
- 4 project-based assessment) or any statute or regulation to the
- 5 contrary, the use of the Keystone Exam as a graduation
- 6 requirement or as a benchmark for the need for participation in
- 7 <u>a project-based assessment shall be delayed until the 2018-2019</u>
- 8 <u>school year.</u>
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
