## AN ACT

1 Appropriating money from the Sunny Day Fund to the Department of  
2 Commerce for the fiscal year 1986-1987.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The sum set forth in this act, or as much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated from  
7 the Sunny Day Fund to the Department of Commerce for the fiscal  
8 year July 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987, for the project listed to  
9 enhance economic development and the creation of jobs in this  
10 Commonwealth in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 1 of  
11 the act of July 1, 1985 (P.L.120, No.32), known as the Sunny Day  
12 Fund Act.

13 Section 2. The following amount is appropriated to the  
14 Department of Commerce to induce Genesis Packaging Systems,  
15 Inc., to locate a product development and manufacturing facility  
16 in Washington County:

17 State appropriation.....\$4,000,000

1       Section 3. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the  
2 appropriation in section 2 will be loaned to Genesis Packaging  
3 Systems, Inc., at an annual interest rate of 3% for a term not  
4 to exceed 15 years. IF GENESIS PACKAGING SYSTEMS CONSTRUCTS A <—  
5 FACILITY AT A LOCATION OUTSIDE THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA  
6 FOR THE COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION OF LAMIPAC OR ASEPTIC PLASTIC FOOD  
7 CONTAINERS OR OTHER THERMOFORM PRODUCTS BEFORE EXPANDING THE  
8 CAPACITY OF THE SPEERS FACILITY FOR PRODUCTION OF SUCH  
9 CONTAINERS, THEN, THE ENTIRE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OUTSTANDING AND  
10 ANY ACCRUED INTEREST THEREON SHALL BECOME DUE AND PAYABLE. It is  
11 expected that this project will create at least 100 new full-  
12 time jobs during the first three years.

13       Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
