AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Philadelphia College of Art,
- 2 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to meet the college deficit for
- 3 the 1970-71 fiscal year.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars
- 7 (\$150,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 8 specifically appropriated to the Philadelphia College of Art,
- 9 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to meet the college deficit caused by
- 10 the failure to make the full appropriation in the fiscal year
- 11 1970-71 because of insufficient revenues, for maintenance and
- 12 the purchase of apparatus, supplies and equipment.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.
