7	Section 1. When requested by a State officer or his deputy	
8	serving as custodian of the premises, a volunteer fire,	
9	AMBULANCE AND RESCUE company or any member thereof is authorized	<
10	to enter Commonwealth-owned premises for the purpose of fighting	
11	a fire.	
12	Section 2. The Attorney General shall provide free legal	
13	assistance to any volunteer fire, AMBULANCE AND RESCUE company	<
14	or fireman MEMBER THEREOF who has entered State lands and	<
15	premises for the purpose of fighting a fire when such volunteer	<
16	fireman or fire company FIRE, AMBULANCE OR RESCUE COMPANY OR	<
17	MEMBER THEREOF is joined as a defendant in any civil action	
18	arising out of the performance of his or its duty under this act
