AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled  
2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," further providing for the time of the physical  
5 examination.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 643, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206,  
9 No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and  
10 amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended to read:

11 Section 643. Physical Examinations.--All applicants for  
12 examination shall undergo a physical examination which shall be  
13 conducted under the supervision of a doctor of medicine  
14 appointed by the commission. No person shall be eligible [to  
15 take an examination] for appointment until said doctor certifies  
16 that the applicant is free from any bodily or mental defects,  
17 deformity or disease that might incapacitate him from the  
18 discharge of the duties of the position desired.

19 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
