AN ACT

- Repealing the act of May 20, 1949 (P.L.1584, No.478), entitled
 "An act defining and prohibiting unfair sales of cigarettes;
 conferring powers and imposing duties on the Department of
 Revenue and on persons, as herein defined, engaged in the
 sale of cigarettes at retail or wholesale; providing for the
 suspension and revocation of Cigarette Tax Permits; and
- 5 suspension and revocation of digarette Tax Permits; a providing remedies and penalties for violations.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of May 20, 1949 (P.L.1584, No.478), known
- 11 as the "Unfair Cigarette Sales Act," is repealed.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
