6 AMENDING THE ACT OF JUNE 30, 1975 (NO. 8-A), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO <—
7 PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND
8 JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH, THE PUBLIC DEBT AND
9 FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD JULY 1, 1975 TO
10 JUNE 30, 1976, AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND
11 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING
12 JUNE 30, 1975," CHANGING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENTS OF
13 TREASURY, COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, HEALTH AND JUSTICE, AND TO THE
14 PHILADELPHIA TRAFFIC COURT AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
15 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR TAY-SACHS DISEASE.

16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
17 hereby enacts as follows:

18 ~~Section 1. The sum of \$77,630 is hereby appropriated to the~~ <—
19 ~~Department of Health for the fiscal year July 1, 1975 to June~~
20 ~~30, 1976, for the establishment of a comprehensive program~~
21 ~~relating to persons with Tay Sachs disease at the Jefferson~~
22 ~~Medical College and Hospital, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Such~~
23 ~~program shall include the detection of Tay Sachs disease in the~~

1 ~~community, counselling of individuals and families, education of~~
2 ~~the public, institution, coordination of research into the~~
3 ~~treatment for Tay Sachs disease and the expansion of genetic~~
4 ~~diagnostic services and treatment of persons with the disease.~~

5 ~~Section 2. The Department of Health shall ascertain that the~~
6 ~~funds appropriated by this act are used by the Jefferson Medical~~
7 ~~College and Hospital, Philadelphia for the purposes set forth in~~
8 ~~this act.~~

10 AS THE "GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 1975," IS AMENDED BY
11 AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE TREASURY DEPARTMENT FOR
12 ADMINISTRATION OF THE BOARD OF FINANCE AND REVENUE; THE
13 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT,
14 AMENDED FEBRUARY 2, 1976 (NO.2-A); TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
15 FOR HEALTH REHABILITATION SERVICES-INSTITUTIONAL, AMENDED
16 DECEMBER 16, 1975 (NO.50-A); TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR
17 ADMINISTRATION EXPENSES FOR DRUG LAW ENFORCEMENT, FOR THE
18 JUVENILE COURT JUDGES COMMISSION AND FOR THE BUREAU OF
19 CORRECTIONS, AMENDED DECEMBER 16, 1975 (NO.50-A); AND TO THE
20 PHILADELPHIA TRAFFIC COURT; AND ADDING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
21 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR A PROGRAM RELATING TO TAY-SACHS
22 DISEASE, TO READ:

23 SECTION 2. THE FOLLOWING SUMS, OR AS MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE
24 NECESSARY, ARE HEREBY SPECIFICALLY APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL
25 FUND TO THE SEVERAL HEREINAFTER NAMED AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE,
26 LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH FOR THE
27 PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES, WAGES OR OTHER COMPENSATION AND TRAVEL
28 EXPENSE OF THE DULY ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES
29 OF THE COMMONWEALTH, FOR PAYMENT OF FEES OF CONTRACTUAL SERVICES
30 RENDERED, FOR THE PURCHASE OR RENTAL OF GOODS, SERVICES,

1 PRINTING, EQUIPMENT, LAND AND BUILDINGS AND FOR PAYMENT OF ANY
2 OTHER EXPENSES, AS PROVIDED BY LAW OR BY THIS ACT, NECESSARY FOR
3 THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES AND
4 FOR THE PURPOSES HEREINAFTER SET FORTH FOR THE FISCAL PERIOD
5 BEGINNING JULY 1, 1975 AND FOR THE PAYMENT OF BILLS INCURRED AND
6 REMAINING UNPAID AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
7 30, 1975.

11 TREATMENT FOR TAY-SACHS DISEASE AND THE EXPANSION
12 OF GENETIC DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES AND TREATMENT OF
13 PERSONS WITH THE DISEASE.

14 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL ASCERTAIN THAT THE
15 FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THIS ACT ARE USED BY THE
16 JEFFERSON MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL, PHILADELPHIA
17 FOR THE PURPOSES HEREIN SET FORTH.
