AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 22, 1951 (P.L.1726, No.463), entitled "An act relating to the loyalty to the United States 3 and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of public officers and employes, including teachers and other employes of the public 5 school system, and officers and employes of State-aided 6 institutions of learning; requiring oaths or affirmations by 7 applicants for public office or employment and by present 8 appointed officers and employes; prohibiting appointment or 9 employment and requiring discharges after hearing in certain cases; imposing conditions on the payment of appropriations 10 to State-aided institutions of learning; requiring statements 11 under oath or affirmation of candidates for elective public 12 13 offices; and imposing duties on State and local appointing 14 authorities and certain other State officers, providing for changes in the loyalty oath. 15
- 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 17 hereby enacts as follows:
- 18 Section 1. Section 4, act of December 22, 1951 (P.L.1726,
- 19 No.463), known as the "Pennsylvania Loyalty Act," amended June
- 20 29, 1967 (P.L.146, No.35), is amended to read:
- 21 Section 4. Procedure in Appointments; Statement and Oath of
- 22 Applicants. -- Every appointing authority shall establish, by
- 23 rules, regulations, or otherwise, procedures designed to
- 24 ascertain, before any person, including teachers and other

- 1 employes of the public school system, is appointed or employed,
- 2 that he is not a subversive person. In the event the applicant
- 3 is deemed to be a subversive person, he shall not be appointed
- 4 or employed. In addition, each applicant shall be required to
- 5 make a written statement, under oath or affirmation, which
- 6 statement shall contain notice that it is subject to the
- 7 penalties of perjury, and shall be in the following form:
- 8 "I,, do solemnly swear (or affirm)
- 9 that I will support, obey and defend the Constitution of the
- 10 United States and the Constitution of this Commonwealth, and
- 11 that I will discharge the duties of
- 12 with fidelity.
- "And I do further swear (or affirm) that I [am not knowingly
- 14 a member with the specific intent to further the aims of any
- 15 organization that advocates,] do not advocate, nor am I a member
- 16 with the specific intent to further the unlawful aims of any
- 17 organization that advocates, immediate action directed to
- 18 inciting or producing imminent lawless action with the
- 19 likelihood that such advocacy will produce or incite such action
- 20 as the overthrow of the government of the United States or of
- 21 this Commonwealth by force or violence or other unconstitutional
- 22 means, or seeking by force or violence to deny other persons
- 23 their rights under the Constitution of the United States or of
- 24 this Commonwealth.
- 25 "And I do further swear (or affirm) that I will not knowingly
- 26 become a member with the specific intent to further the <u>unlawful</u>
- 27 aims of such organization during the period that I am an employe
- 28 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (or political subdivision
- 29 thereof)."
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
