AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for a modified schedule of subsidy payments to school districts.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2517, act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended June
- 11 26, 1974 (No.125), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 2517. Tertiary Payments. -- The amount apportioned and
- 13 allotted to each school district shall be divided into three
- 14 payments and the Secretary of Education shall draw his
- 15 requisition three times annually upon the State Treasurer in
- 16 favor of each district for the amount to which it is entitled.
- 17 The first two payments shall be estimates based on but not to
- 18 exceed [thirty percent (30%)] thirty-five percent (35%) each of
- 19 the total amount apportioned and allocated to the school
- 20 district during the previous school year for the same purposes.

- 1 The final payment shall be the balance of the apportionment due
- 2 for the applicable school year. Payment thereof shall be made to
- 3 all school districts on the first day of [October, February and
- 4 June, except any school district whose fiscal year and calendar
- 5 year are identical at the effective date of this amendatory act
- 6 shall continue to receive payments as heretofor.] September,
- 7 January and May.
- 8 This section shall apply to payments which a school district
- 9 is entitled under any provision of sections 2502, 2592, 2502.3
- 10 or 2502.4.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
