## AN ACT

- 1 To prohibit members of the General Assembly and officials of the
- 2 Executive Department from conducting regular radio or
- 3 television programs for pay.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Definitions.--As used in this act:
- 7 "Compensation" means any thing of economic value, however
- 8 designated which is paid, loaned, granted, given, donated or
- 9 transferred, or to be paid, loaned, granted, given, donated, or
- 10 transferred for or in consideration of services rendered.
- 11 "Member" includes a Senator, Representative, officer or
- 12 employee of the General Assembly or the Commonwealth or any
- 13 committee thereof; but not a person employed on a contractual
- 14 basis or without compensation for a particular project.
- 15 "Official" means any officer of the Executive Department of
- 16 the Commonwealth elected by the general public and any appointed
- 17 official who is required to be confirmed by the Senate.
- 18 Section 2. No member or official shall receive compensation

- 1 for conducting a regular radio or television program.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 2
