## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An
- 2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,
- 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto, " making an additional change to conform to existing
- 5 law.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 410, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69),
- 9 known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended
- 10 July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and amended July 13, 1961
- 11 (P.L.596, No.294), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 410. Supervisors. -- Except as is otherwise provided
- 13 for the election of additional supervisors in townships having a
- 14 population of [ten] three thousand or more, at each municipal
- 15 election, the electors of each township shall elect one
- 16 supervisor to serve for a term of six years from the first
- 17 Monday of January next following his election.
- 18 Except as provided in section 514, no supervisor shall at the
- 19 time hold any other elective or appointive township office or
- 20 position other than township roadmaster or secretary-treasurer.

- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall 1
- 2 be retroactive to March 1, 1974.
