## AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare for 2 the publicizing of the "Operation Peace of Mind" program.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$30,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public
- 7 Welfare in order to publicize the "Operation Peace of Mind"
- 8 program which is a National toll-free hot-line for runaways.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
