## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," increasing amount of levy permitted for fire protection.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Clause (6) of section 1302, act of February 1,
8	1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," is
9	amended to read:
10	Section 1302. Tax LevyThe council of the borough shall
11	have power, by ordinance, to levy and collect annually, a tax,
12	not exceeding thirty mills for general borough purposes and in
13	addition thereto any of the following taxes:
14	* * *
15	(6) For the purchase of fire engines, fire apparatus and

16 fire hose for the use of the borough, or for assisting any fire 17 company in the borough in the purchase, renewal or repair of any

of its fire engines, fire apparatus or fire hose, for the 1 purposes of making appropriations to fire companies both within 2 3 and without the borough and of contracting with adjacent municipalities OR VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES THEREIN for fire 4 protection, or for the purchase of land upon which to erect a 5 fire house, or for the erection and maintenance of a fire house 6 or fire houses, not exceeding three mills. [, such additional 7 8 millage permitted only following a favorable referendum on the matter held in accordance with the provisions of the act of 9 April 18, 1923 (P.L.70, No.46), as amended;] If an annual tax 10 11 for the purposes specified in this clause is proposed to be set 12 at a level higher than three mills, the question shall be 13 submitted to the voters of the borough, and the county board of elections shall frame the question in accordance with the 14 election laws of the Commonwealth for submission to the voters 15 16 of the borough; \* \* \* 17

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18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
