## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
- 2 "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
- 3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto, " authorizing appropriations for observances and
- 5 celebrations.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206,
- 9 No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and
- 10 amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a
- 11 clause to read:
- 12 Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first
- 13 class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners.
- 14 The board shall have power--
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 LXVIII. Appropriations for Observances and Celebrations.--To
- 17 appropriate annually an amount not to exceed seven hundred fifty
- 18 dollars (\$750) for the observance of holidays, centennials or
- 19 other anniversaries or for township celebrations or civic

- 1 projects or programs.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
