## AN ACT

- 1 Exempting residents of the Commonwealth who are sixty-five years
- of age or older from paying tuition at any college or
- 3 university that receives an appropriation from the
- 4 Commonwealth.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Any legal resident of the Commonwealth who is 65
- 8 years of age or older shall be exempt from paying tuition at any
- 9 college or university which receives an appropriation from the
- 10 Commonwealth. Admission to classes will be on a space available
- 11 basis as determined by the college or university.
- 12 Section 2. No additional contributions to the college or
- 13 university from the Commonwealth or school districts shall be
- 14 required for the purposes of this act.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
