AN ACT

1 Exempting residents of the Commonwealth who are sixty-five years
2 of age or older from paying tuition at any college or
3 university that receives an appropriation from the
4 Commonwealth.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Any legal resident of the Commonwealth who is 65
8 years of age or older shall be exempt from paying tuition at any
9 college or university which receives an appropriation from the
10 Commonwealth. Admission to classes will be on a space available
11 basis as determined by the college or university.

12 Section 2. No additional contributions to the college or
13 university from the Commonwealth or school districts shall be
14 required for the purposes of this act.

15 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
