AN ACT

- 1 Requiring Federal Government gasoline mileage test results to be disclosed to purchasers of new motor vehicles.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Mileage Test Results Disclosure. -- Any person who
- 6 offers for sale any new motor vehicle for which an agency of the
- 7 Federal Government has determined by testing an average rating
- 8 of miles per gallon of gasoline shall disclose in writing to any
- 9 potential purchaser of such motor vehicle the results of the
- 10 mileage test for the make and model of the motor vehicle
- 11 involved.
- 12 Section 2. Regulations. -- The Attorney General may by
- 13 regulations promulgate standards for mileage test results
- 14 disclosure.
- 15 Section 3. Effective Date. -- This act shall take effect in 60
- 16 days.
