AN ACT

Repealing the act of August 27, 1971 (P.L.358, No.92), entitled 2 "An act creating an authority for the purpose of avoiding 3 increased costs of public education by providing partial reimbursement for nonpublic education and defining its powers 5 and duties, " transferring all moneys in the Parent Reimbursement Fund to the General Fund and providing for the 7 contingency of future claims against the Parent Reimbursement 8 Fund. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. It is hereby determined and declared as a matter 12 of legislative finding: 13 That on June 25, 1973, the United States Supreme Court declared unconstitutional the act of August 27, 1971 (P.L.358, 14 No.92), known as the "Parent Reimbursement Act for Nonpublic 15 16 Education."

- 17 That litigation is presently pending in which parents
- are seeking reimbursement under the act for all or part of the 18
- 19 tuition they paid for their children to attend nonpublic schools
- 20 for the two years between the passage of the Parent
- 21 Reimbursement Act for Nonpublic Education and its subsequent

- 1 declaration of unconstitutionality by the United States Supreme
- 2 Court.
- 3 (3) That the outcome of this litigation may not be finally
- 4 resolved for a period of years.
- 5 (4) That moneys accumulated pursuant to the Parent
- 6 Reimbursement Act for Nonpublic Education are presently in a
- 7 special fund created by said act.
- 8 (5) That until such time as said litigation is resolved, the
- 9 existence of said moneys in a special fund precludes their use
- 10 for other more pressing and immediate demands of the
- 11 Commonwealth and its citizens.
- 12 Section 2. The act of August 27, 1971 (P.L.358, No.92),
- 13 known as the "Parent Reimbursement Act for Nonpublic Education"
- 14 is repealed.
- 15 Section 3. All moneys in the Parent Reimbursement Fund on
- 16 the effective date of this act are hereby transferred to the
- 17 General Fund.
- 18 Section 4. All records, books, accounts and other documents
- 19 of or pertaining to or having any relation with the Parent
- 20 Reimbursement Authority created by the Parent Reimbursement Act
- 21 for Nonpublic Education which are presently being maintained by
- 22 said authority are hereby transferred to the Department of
- 23 Education.
- 24 Section 5. Should a judgment be entered in any pending
- 25 litigation authorizing the payment of any claims arising against
- 26 the Parent Assistance Authority concerning reimbursement for
- 27 tuition for the school years 1971-1972 and 1972-1973, then such
- 28 claims authorized to be paid by said judgment shall be paid out
- 29 of the General Fund of the State Treasury.
- 30 Section 6. The act shall take effect immediately.
