1 2 3	Making appropriations to the Department of Environmental Resources for continuation of gypsy moth and hemlock looper moth controls.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
б	Section 1. The sum of \$500,000, or as much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated for the fiscal
8	period July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976 to the Department of
9	Environmental Resources for the control of the gypsy moth.
10	Section 2. The sum of \$50,000, or as much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated for the fiscal
12	period July 1, 1975 to June 30, 1976 to the Department of
13	Environmental Resources for the control of the hemlock looper
14	moth.
15	Section 3. The Department of Environmental Resources shall
16	prepare for and report to the General Assembly data concerning
17	the feasibility and cost of utilizing, in lieu of spraying
18	programs, parasitic insects to control gypsy moths, hemlock

- 1 looper moths, oak leaf roller and other forest pests.
- 2 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
