AN ACT

1 Prohibiting smoking in certain places and providing penalties.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

3 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Smoking in Certain Places.--(a) No person shall
smoke any cigars, cigarettes or tobacco in any elevator, indoor
theatre, museum, library, bus, or in the room of a patient in a
hospital.

8 (b) No school student shall smoke any cigars, cigarettes or 9 tobacco in any school building or on the school grounds.

10 Section 2. Penalty.--Any person violating the provisions of 11 this act shall upon summary conviction, be sentenced to pay a 12 fine of \$10 plus costs of prosecution.

Section 3. Public Education Program.--The Department of Health is hereby directed to initiate a public educational program to apprise the public of the health hazards of smoking. Section 4. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
