## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) further providing for
- the use of deadly force by peace officers under certain
- 3 circumstances.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 508 of Title 18, act of
- 7 November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes, added December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482,
- 9 No.334), is amended to read:
- 10 § 508. Use of force in law enforcement.
- 11 (a) Peace officer's use of force in making arrest.--
- 12 (1) A peace officer, or any person whom he has summoned
- or directed to assist him, need not retreat or desist from
- 14 efforts to make a lawful arrest because of resistance or
- threatened resistance to the arrest. He is justified in the
- 16 use of any force which he believes to be necessary to effect
- the arrest and of any force which he believes to be necessary
- 18 to defend himself or another from bodily harm while making
- 19 the arrest. However, he is justified in using deadly force

- only when he believes that such force is necessary to prevent
- death or serious bodily injury to himself or such other
- 3 person, or when he believes both that:
- 4 (i) such force is necessary to prevent the arrest
- from being defeated by resistance or escape; and
- 6 (ii) the person to be arrested has committed or
- 7 attempted a forcible felony [or is attempting to escape
- 8 and possesses a deadly weapon, or otherwise indicates
- 9 that he will endanger human life or inflict serious
- 10 bodily injury unless arrested without delay].
- 11 (2) A peace officer making an arrest pursuant to an
- invalid warrant is justified in the use of any force which he
- would be justified in using if the warrant were valid, unless
- 14 he knows that the warrant is invalid.

- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
