## AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, 2 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating 3 thereto, " authorizing townships to enter into contracts with 4 5 the Commonwealth for police protection. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Clause LIV of section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 8 9 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is 10 11 amended to read: 12 Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first 13 class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power--14 15 16 LIV.
