AN ACT

- Prohibiting prosecutions for the use of weapons in the defense of a person's dwelling or his life.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. No person shall be prosecuted under the
- 6 provisions of the act of December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334),
- 7 known as the "Crimes Code," for the use of a weapon in the
- 8 defense of his dwelling place or his life.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
