AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 14, 1963 (P.L.839, No.407), entitled,
2 as amended, "An act creating a county records committee;
3 imposing powers and duties upon it; authorizing the
4 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission to assist and
5 cooperate with it; defining county records; and authorizing
6 the disposition of certain county records by county officers
7 in counties of the second A and third to eighth class,"
8 including counties of the second class.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. The title and section 4, act of August 14, 1963
12 (P.L.839, No.407), entitled, as amended "An act creating a
13 county records committee; imposing powers and duties upon it;
14 authorizing the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission to
15 assist and cooperate with it; defining county records; and
16 authorizing the disposition of certain county records by county
17 officers in counties of the second A and third to eighth class,"
18 amended November 22, 1968 (P.L.1083, No.335), are amended to
19 read:

1 upon it; authorizing the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum
2 Commission to assist and cooperate with it; defining county
3 records; and authorizing the disposition of certain county
4 records by county officers in counties of the [second A and
5 third] second to eighth class.

6 Section 4. County officers in counties of the second, second
7 A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class may
8 dispose of all county records in their custody, provided they
9 follow the schedules prescribed by the county records committee
10 which is created under the provisions of this act, and provided
11 that the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission through
12 its executive director, certifies that such disposal is in
13 accordance with the established schedules.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
