- 6 Section 4. County officers in counties of the second, second
- 7 A, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth class may
- 8 dispose of all county records in their custody, provided they
- 9 follow the schedules prescribed by the county records committee
- 10 which is created under the provisions of this act, and provided
- 11 that the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission through
- 12 its executive director, certifies that such disposal is in
- 13 accordance with the established schedules.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
