AN ACT

Amending the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), entitled 2 "An act relating to the manufacture, sale and possession of controlled substances, other drugs, devices and cosmetics; 3 conferring powers on the courts and the secretary and 5 Department of Health, and a newly created Pennsylvania Drug, Device and Cosmetic Board; establishing schedules of 7 controlled substances; providing penalties; requiring 8 registration of persons engaged in the drug trade and for the revocation or suspension of certain licenses and 9 registrations; and repealing an act, "further defining 10 "device." 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 13 14 The definition of "device" in subsection (b) of 15 section 2, act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, " is amended 17 to read: Section 2. Definitions. -- * * * 18 (b) As used in this act: 19 20 21 "Device" means instruments, apparatus and contrivances, 22 including their components, parts and accessories, except dental

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
